- Receive 'Heartbeat', our monthly newsletter which is sent to all our members to keep you up to date on news and events around Papakura, opportunities and information we think you may be interested in.
- Regular updates and clarification about Auckland council by-laws and submission and feedback process.
 We help you to have your say on issues which affect you and your business.
- 'Business After 5' bi-monthly Wednesday network functions and Business Breakfasts with keynote speakers – all encourage networking opportunities, information sharing and making connections with other business members.

 prizes for competitions and promotions. The gift vouchers must be redeemed at Papakura businesses. This
 keeps more money in our town.

- Papakura Community Safety Co-ordinator employed to look after safety issues for the town centre.

- Access to Safety Subsidies for CCTV and Shop front lighting, using PBA preferred suppliers

Associate Members pay an annual membership fee of \$250 plus Gst which includes your listing on the website. Associate members enjoy all the same benefits as members inside the BID, with the only exception being that associate members are not entitled to vote at the AGM
